First, do a thorough pre-flight equipment check – is everything set up correctly?

...And check the weather you must always be able to see and control your drone.

Consider others unless you have their OK, stay away from private property, people and crowds.

If you're going to a park, check with the council that it's OK to fly a drone.

While there are some exceptions, don't fly within 4-kilometres of any type of airport or helipad.

Keep below 120 metres – it's still plenty high enough to have fun.

It's safer to fly in open areas – that's to protect privacy

...and your drone.

If emergency services need to do their thing, get out of the way and land immediately.

...Or aircraft won't go in...

Basically, fly your drone responsibly while considering other people....

... and their property.

That's how you fly the right way.
